- 1. Residence Requirements**
 - 30 MSU resident credits
 - 27 credits on East Lansing campus after junior status
 - Last 20 credits while enrolled in CAL and in major
- 2. Overall GPA of at least 2.0; major GPA of at least 2.0.**
- 3. Credits**
 - Total of 120 credits minimum; 123 credits for students who took MTH 1825; 153 credits for second major students
 - At least 30 credits at the 300- and 400-level
 - No more than 40 credits in major area
 - Maximum of 10 of last 30 credits done via transfer credits.
 - No more than 10% credits of independent study courses.
 - Students may not transfer credits from a community college after they have **56 credits**.
 - Transfer students can only transfer **60 credits**.
